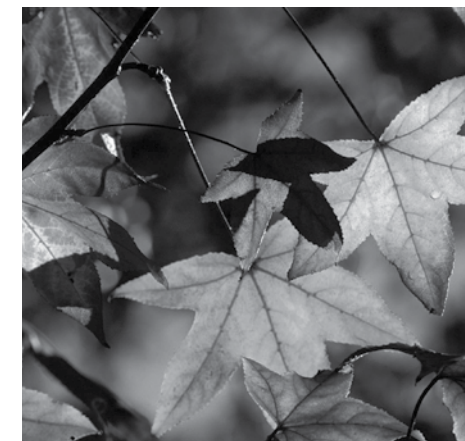

Now in its 15th year of excellent performance, KIK has been recognized as the premiere youth choir in the Pacific Northwest! KIK is comprised of students ages 8 - 18 (under 8 requires director approval).



In addition to a holiday concert in December and spring concert in April, KIK has the honor of performing at several events in the Puget Sound. Other annual concerts generally include the Singing Christmas Tree at Downtown for The Holidays in Sylvester Park, the tree lighting ceremony at the Capitol Rotunda, and a holiday performance with the Army & Navy Band at JBLMC! KIK also sang for the opening of the 2011 Legislative Session.

MONUMENTAL TOUR!

Every other year is a travel year for the choir and in Spring 2012 Kids in Koncert will travel to Washington D.C. & NYC!! Policies to be aware of:

- **Registration for Kids in Koncert requires a commitment to travel with the choir.**
- Family members may sign up to join the trip, however if you sign up to travel with the group you will be subject to their travel itinerary. Family member cost is \$1700. Trip must be paid in full by February 1, 2012.
- A payment plan is available for trip costs:
Student plan - Deposit of \$250 in August with 5 payments of \$250
Family plan - Deposit of \$250 in August with 5 payments of \$290 (Payments due in Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan & Feb)

Class and KIK Enrollment Rules

The Capital Playhouse academic year program is designed for students ages 8 - 18 who are interested in expanding their performance skills.

- We enroll up to the first day of class on a "first come, first served" basis. Early enrollment is encouraged.
- A \$75 deposit per class is required. Tuition balance is due by the first day of class or KIK rehearsal.
- Deposits are nonrefundable and MAY NOT be transferred to family members.
- A medical/emergency card is required on all students.
