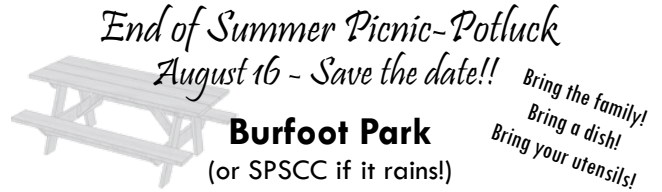


Turning Leaf Productions will be selling DVDs of each production. Pick up a form in the SPSCC lobby before the show or at intermission.
